- Diversification among equity and fixed income allocations
- Choice of asset allocations – 40/60, 60/40 and 80/20 equity to fixed income ratios

- Diversified portfolio seeking market rate returns using socially responsible strategies
- 80/20 equity to fixed income asset allocation

For charitable funds with assets of \$1 million or more, donors may recommend a trusted investment advisor to manage the fund and ensure its growth.

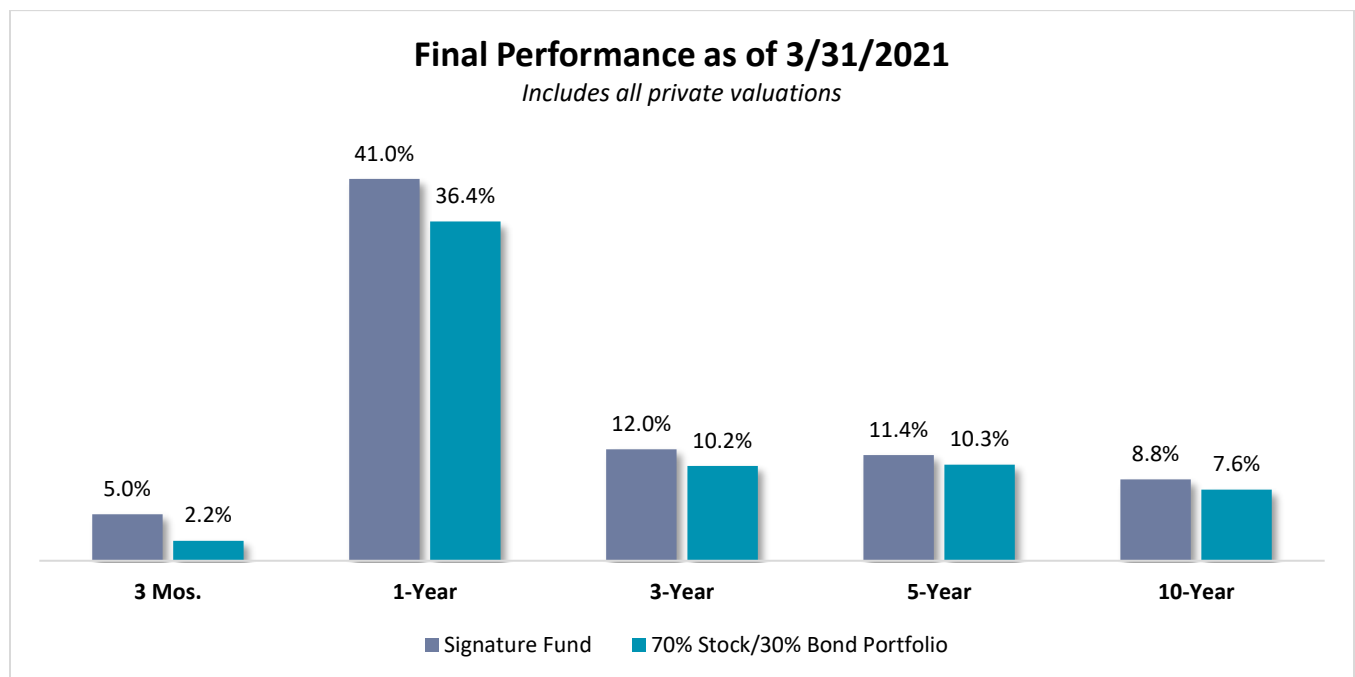
