Determining Financial Need

Students, before you begin this section, you must complete FAFSA¹ (<https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa>) so that you can list your Student Aid Index (SAI) amount. There are a number of community groups that can help you with the FAFSA such as GRASP www.grasp4va.org.

What college/university are you planning to attend? If you have not yet made a selection, use the 1 st choice school that you listed in your application.		
	What is this school's Cost Of Attendance ? <i>This can be found on the school's website. Cost of attendance includes tuition and fees, books and supplies, room and board, transportation, and personal expenses. Colleges adjust the COA yearly to reflect changes to these costs.</i>	\$
A	What is the Student Aid Index (SAI) listed on your FAFSA Submission Summary?	\$
B	All Scholarships and Grants offered to date (this includes other scholarships provided by the college and Pell Grant, etc.). Do not include loans or those scholarships you have applied for but have not yet been awarded.	\$
C	Financial Need (Subtract line A and B from Cost of Attendance).	\$

Note: You will have an opportunity to provide additional information about financial considerations that may not be apparent from your FAFSA in the **Statement of Financial Need** section of your application.
